The community of ABBA Father Mission - Nyamlell presents its annual report for the year 2021. This parish was established in the year 1933 by Comboni Missionaries and we are continuing the mission. The parish is named after St. Theresa of child Jesus and it celebrated its Diamond Jubilee -- 75 years -- On Oct. 1, 2009. From the year 2012 the MMI missionaries are continuing the service under the diocese of Wau.

## 4. PASTORAL MINISTRIES

There are 18 centers, and 110 chapels under St. Teresa of Child Jesus parish Nyamlell. Among those 14 centers have easy access to road and to reach them. 4 centers are located interior places and during rainy seasons it is difficult to administer sacraments for them. We are located at the Centre and we are to cover around 80 km far from our parish to all the directions (NEWS) to different centers.

We visit and celebrate mass at three different places per Sunday. At this time, we thank St. Peter Claver from Rome for providing with us two motor bike that we could reach the people for their sacramental needs. Some of the chapels are not active, due to the lack of visits to their center and the catechists are not regular in gathering the people for prayers... ### 5.1.SCHOOL DEVELOPMENTAL ACTIVITIES

- Renovation of four classroom with cement flooring - Nyamlell
  - In the beginning of the year, we renovated four classrooms with cement flooring and fixing the black board.
- Purchase of 30 sets of desk and bench from VTC Wau.

- Children were bringing chairs from home for the secondary school SHHS, we could provide them with desk and bench through the people of good will from SVG Denmark.
- Purchase of black boards to St Mary Makuei school
- Purchase of Chairs for the teachers at Makuei School
- Providing uniform for free for the needy children
- Approval of secondary under GESS
  - This year we processed our application to get aid from GESS. With the help of our Parishioners we could achieve it. And in the month of November our secondary girls in number 56 received 5500 SSP from GESS
- Lab apparatus
  - There are number of primary schools around our locality and all of them struggle to get good secondary school near. Thus it is our effort to strengthen secondary school with lab facilities. And we made it.
- MOU with New Life Ministry for getting teachers to our school
  - This is one of our efforts to share the knowledge of our neighboring school teachers.
- Water facilities at the school premises
  - We fixed the water facilities at the secondary school campus through the help of Christian aid. Now the children have water point at the school premises.
  - Also, we fixed the hand pump at Makuei
- Improving the life of teachers
- Teachers are given motivation to take care of the students, also from this year we are providing tea for the teachers. There are 10 voluntary teachers have been given incentive through the help of SVG.
- Mother virgin educational scheme
  - The orphan and semi orphan children are given free education through this scheme this academy there are 14 children benefitted through this scheme. Also we help the needy children with uniform and notebooks.

## 7. MISSION CHALLENGES

There are numerous challenges in this mission land. But when we come close to live with people we can feel our challenges can be turned into blessings for the people whom we have come to serve.

Still, we present our situations what we encounter at the mission

- The mission place has no fence for the church or for the religious house, children here are very active in breaking the glasses, locks, doors, windows at the school and church. Parents have no control over them, and we time and again instruct them to take care of the church properties.
- education department looking for the way to take advantages of all the aid that are coming from NGOs to the school and from children. That results in very poor relationship with the county. The people's mentality is that missionaries should always get from abroad and to provide them. We try our level best teach them to stand on our own.
- Financial struggle to organize program for all the groups (youth, altar boys, choir, legion of Mary, alleluia dancers, parish council) of the church other than the feast days.

If there is no challenge, then it can't be called a mission. Our mission is big, and it is our God given gift to live and get experience of God through the people of South Sudan. Getting the real missionaries, who will live and die for the faithful is our expectation. We need real missionaries. There is always need and God provides the needy through people of good will.
